

**God has given us spiritual weapons that are mighty through God to destroy enemy strongholds of sin and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God:*

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 (NKJV) ³ For though we walk in the flesh, we do not *conduct our spiritual war according to the flesh.* ^{4a} For the weapons of our *spiritual warfare* are not carnal ^b **but mighty in God** ^c for pulling down strongholds, ^{5a} casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, ^b bringing every thought into captivity/*submission* to the obedience of Christ, ^{6a} and being ready to punish all disobedience ^b when your obedience is fulfilled.

**The enemy we are fighting against in our Spiritual warfare:*

Ephesians 6:12 (KJV) ^{12a} For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *heavenly* places.

**Things to remember in our Spiritual warfare against the enemy:*

Colossians 2:9-10 (NKJV) ⁹ For in Jesus dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily¹⁰ and you are complete in Him, Who is the head of all principality and power.

Colossians 2:15 (NKJV) ¹⁵ Having disarmed principalities and powers, Jesus Christ made a public spectacle of them *at the cross*, triumphing over them in it.

1 John 4:4 (NKJV) ⁴ You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
